

INKARA Crimson clover

(*Trifolium incarnatum*)



INKARA is an annual overwintering clover with very high yields

Key features:

- x Very high yields
- x Excellent resistant to lodging
- x Mid early flowering
- x Not sensitive to frost
- x Good resistant to diseases
- x Very fast establishment

INKARA is a variety of the Slovenian breeding Institute, exclusively represented by Westyard. INKARA is a high forage quality variety which can grow in various soil conditions. Inkara is very cold tolerant and has an excellent nutritional value. Inkara has dark green leaves and flowers between the second half of April and first half of May. It has a good resistance to lodging and diseases.

INKARA has very high seed yields with medium to high content of crude proteins. It is primarily used for fresh feed but also in mixtures with Italian ryegrass and other annual overwintering catch crops.

Seed density : 5 – 10kg/ha

Seed depth : 0,5 – 1,0cm

Fertilization : pH min 5.0
