

MARIETA Red clover

(*Trifolium pratense* L.)



MARIETA is a medium-early variety, well-balanced in terms of forage, quality and yield

Key features:

- x Flexible and adaptable variety in all kind of areas
- x Excellent resistance to diseases, especially leaf scorch
- x Convenient for cultivation in monoculture, undersowing and clover-grass mixtures
- x Very good resistance to mildew, stem rot and anthracnose
- x Well balanced in terms of forage quality and seed
- x Very winterhard

MARIETA, a diploid variety, has a high forage and hay quality and high production of crude protein. Rapid re-growth after each cut increases its agronomic value and enables three harvests in one year. During several tests MARIETA exceeded the control varieties in production of gross proteins by 16%. Also in green mass (5,4%) and hay harvests (5,8%) it turned out to be better than the other varieties. Because of these characteristics MARIETA is top in the range of diploid varieties.

Seed density : 10 - 12kg/ha

Seed depth : 0,5 - 1,0cm

Soil : pH min 5.0
