

KATJA White/Yellow Mustard

(*Sinapis alba*, nematode resistant)



KATJA is a stable variety with very high seed yields.

KATJA is our new variety and is registered on the EU list since 2020 with the following characteristics:

- x High yield of valuable organic matter
- x Very fast covering
- x Diploid variety
- x Very early until early flowering
- x Intensive, deep-reaching root system
- x Active protection against erosion
- x Mid-high to high in length
- x Resistant to lodging
- x Reduces beet cyst nematodes
- x Nematode resistant

KATJA can be sown until very late in the autumn. It grows very quickly providing good ground cover, making it an excellent green manuring crop. KATJA is a stable variety with high seed yields. It is a nematode resistant variety and very suitable as an intercrop in a sugar-, cereal- and potatoe rotation.

Sowing : early July until late September
Seed density : 15 - 20 kg/ha
Seed depth : 1 - 2 cm
Fertilization : 40 - 60 kg/ha N
